

This airstrip is not shown on air navigation maps or listed in any publications. It now has few obstacles or hazards, but use is at pilots risk. Check aircraft insurance for use of uncharted and nonpublished airstrips.

Obstacles:

- * 50 ft tall power poles that run 145 ft parallel to the right side (east) of approach to Rwy 36.
- * Diagonal tree line on the East side of the South end of the runway can cause erratic air movement with southeast wind.
- * Beware of vehicles, farm machinery, domestic & wild animals, and other possible obstacles on runway.

**The runway is a 50ft wide x 2600 ft long unimproved north/south sod runway with a 1200 ft gravel road over-run on the south end.


